1	SECTION 1. MINIMUM STAFFING REQUIREMENTS FOR LOW-
2	INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE.
3	The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of
4	1981 (42 U.S.C. 8621 et seq.) is amended by adding at
5	the end the following:
6	"SEC. 2613. STAFFING.
7	"(a) In General.—The Secretary shall employ at
8	least 20 staff who carry out this title.
9	"(b) Limitation on Employment of Contrac-
10	TORS.—Except as provided in subsection (c)(2), no more
11	than 40 percent of staff who carry out this title may be
12	contractors.
13	"(c) Emergency Staffing.—
14	"(1) In general.—In the case of an emer-
15	gency determined under section 2603(1)(C), (E),
16	(F), or (G), the Secretary shall employ at least 30
17	staff who carry out this title during the period—
18	"(A) beginning not later than 45 days
19	after the date of such determination; and
20	"(B) ending no earlier than 180 days after
21	the date of such determination.
22	"(2) Employment of contractors.—The
23	Secretary may hire contractors to comply with the
24	requirements of paragraph (1) in a number that ex-
25	ceeds the limitation set forth in subsection (b).".
