SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

8	"(a) The provisions of this Act may be extended to
9	the Gulf Cooperation Council in the same manner, to the

11	may be extended to a public international organization in
12	which the United States participates pursuant to any trea-
13	ty or under the authority of any Act of Congress author-
14	izing such participation or making an appropriation for
15	such participation.
16	"(b) Under such terms and conditions as the Presi-
17	dent shall determine, consistent with the purposes of this
18	Act, the President is authorized to extend, or enter into
19	an agreement to extend, to the Gulf Cooperation Council,
20	and to its members, the privileges and immunities enjoyed
21	by diplomatic missions accredited to the United States,
22	and by members of such missions, subject to cor-
