Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Nash Road Drainage Improvements project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of North Salem, located at 266 Titicus Road, North Salem, NY, 10560. The funding would be used for stormwater conveyances, upsized pipes, large diameter stormwater pipes, and large catch basins in order to contain stormwater during rainfall events and prevent flooding in the area.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it provides funding for sustainable, cost-effective measures to provide long-term, permanent risk reduction to individuals and property from storm events and flooding. These priorities closely align with the purposes of the Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant program.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
