A BILL

To prohibit the procurement of certain items containing perfluorooctane sulfonate or perfluorooctanoic acid and prioritize the procurement of products not containing PFAS.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PFAS–Free Procure-
5 ment Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PROCUREMENT OF CERTAIN**
2 **ITEMS CONTAINING PFOS OR PFOA.**

3 (a) PROHIBITION.—The head of an executive agency
4 may not renew or enter into a contract for the procure-
5 ment of a covered item that contains PFOS or PFOA.

6 (b) PRIORITY PROCUREMENT OF PRODUCTS NOT
7 CONTAINING PFAS.—The head of an executive agency
8 shall prioritize the procurement of covered items, where
9 available and practicable, that do not contain PFAS.

10 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

11 (1) EXECUTIVE AGENCY.—The term “executive
12 agency” has the meaning given the term in section
13 133 of title 41, United States Code.

14 (2) COVERED ITEM.—The term “covered item”
15 means—

16 (A) nonstick cookware and a cooking uten-
17 sil; and

18 (B) furniture, carpet, and any rug treated
19 with stain-resistant coating.

20 (3) PFAS.—The term “PFAS” means harmful
21 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances.

22 (4) PFOA.—The term “PFOA” means
23 perfluorooctanoic acid.

24 (5) PFOS.—The term “PFOS” means
25 perfluorooctane sulfonate.

1 (d) APPLICABILITY.—This section shall take effect 6
2 months after the date of the enactment of this Act and
3 shall apply with respect to any contract entered into on
4 and after such effective date.
